Shizuoka Prefectural Fujinokuni Junior High School 2024 Recruitment Guidelines

1 Purpose of studying at Shizuoka Prefectural Fujinokuni Junior High School

It is a school for people who did not finish their 9 year education (elementary school to junior high school) due to unforeseeable circumstances or those who graduated from junior high school but barely attended school to study junior high school level academic subjects. It is not a place to study Japanese.

2 School location

- Iwata Main Campus

Address: 1-6-16 Nakaizumi, Iwata City, Shizuoka Prefecture, 3rd floor, Tempyo-no-Machi

- Mishima Campus

Address: 1-3-93 Bunkyocho, Mishima City, Shizuoka Prefecture

Mishima Choryo High School, 6th floor

* Classes will be held from 5 pm to 9 pm.

3 Admission qualifications

Applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- Resident of Shizuoka Prefecture.
- Age 15 years or older by April 1, 2024 (people born before April 1, 2009).
- Has not completed elementary school or junior high school in Japan or abroad or has graduated from junior high school without attending classes.
- For foreign nationals, he/she must not have a "foreign student" status of residence indicated in his/her residence card

4 School district

Anyone living in Shizuoka Prefecture can enroll in either school.

- We will decide your school placement by taking into consideration your request in the application form.

5 Application procedure

- Please personally submit the necessary documents to the Fujinokuni Junior High School Iwata Campus or Mishima Campus or send it by registered mail.
- By registered mail, please call the Fujinokuni Junior High School Iwata Campus or Mishima Campus prior to sending the documents. Make sure to send it by registered mail (*kan-i kakitome*).
- Transportation expenses for personal submission of documents and/or postage fee for mailing shall be borne by the applicant.

(1) Application period

July 3, 2023 (Monday) until July 14, 2023 (Friday)

A. By personal submission: 10:45 am until 8:45 pm

(Excluding Saturday and Sunday)

B. By mail: Must be postmarked by Friday, July 14, 2023.

(2) Documents to be submitted (required documents)

Please submit the documents listed in A to E using an A4 envelope (*kakugata 2gō*) and attach the address label (write your postal code, address and name). When sending by mail, please attach a stamp worth 460 yen and make sure to send it by registered mail (*kan-i kakitome*).

A. Application form (Form No. 1-2)

B. Interview documents (Form No. 2)

C. Residence certificate (*jūminhyō*) (original and 1 photocopy) * For Japanese nationals only

- Issued within the last 3 months.

- The following details can be omitted on the residence certificate.

(Permanent domicile (*honseki*), information of other household members, My number information, residence certificate code, name of head of household, and your relationship to the head of household)

D. Copy of residence card (front and back) * For foreign nationals only

E. Self-addressed reply envelopes (2 envelopes)

Please attach your address label (write your postal code, address, and name) on the reply envelope, and a stamp worth 404 yen on each long envelope (*nagagata 3gō*).

Document forms and address labels are available for download from the Shizuoka Prefectural Fujinokuni Junior High School website.

It is also available at the office of the Compulsory Education Division (*Gimukyōiku-ka*), Shizuoka Prefectural Board of Education, Tenpyo-no-Machi (3F), and Mishima Choryo High School (6F).

(3) Change of address

If you change your address after submitting your application for admission, please contact the Fujinokuni Junior High School Iwata Campus or Mishima Campus by phone or e-mail immediately. (You can also contact us through the "Inquiry Form" on the Shizuoka Prefectural Fujinokuni Junior High School website.)

6 Interview

(1) Venue

Shizuoka Prefectural Fujinokuni Junior High School Iwata Main Campus or Mishima Classroom

(2) Interview procedure

The interview will be about 20 minutes long.

We will check your admission qualifications and ask about your goals after enrollment.

(3) Interview date

▪ July 31, 2023 (Monday), August 1, 2023 (Tuesday), August 8, 2023 (Thursday)

▪ You will be notified by the Fujinokuni Junior High School of the venue and date of your interview by mail on July 21, 2023 (Friday).

▪ If you are unavailable on the day of the interview, call the Fujinokuni Junior High School from July 24th (Monday) to July 28th (Friday), 2023 and request for a change of schedule.

Office hours: 10:45 am to 8:45 pm

(Until noon on Friday, July 28)

7 Selection of students

Successful applicants will be decided based on the submitted application documents and interview.

(1) Notification of interview results

The interview result notice will be sent by mail on Thursday, August 17, 2023.

(2) Confirmation of feelings of admission

▪ Those who are eligible for admission based on the interview result notification should complete the enclosed intent to enroll confirmation form (Form No. 3). Submit Form No. 3 personally to the Fujinokuni Junior High School or send it by mail.

▪ If you send by mail, please call the Fujinokuni Junior High School before sending. Make sure to send it by registered mail (*kan-i kakitome*).

▪ Expenses to personally submit the documents or postage fees for mailing are to be borne by the applicant.

▪ Submission period: Date of receipt of the interview result notification ~ August 25, 2023 (Friday)

A. Personal submission: 10:45 am to 8:45 pm, Monday to Friday

B. By mail: Must be postmarked by August 23, 2023 (Wednesday).

▪ You will not be able to enroll if you do not submit the intent to enroll confirmation form by August 23, 2023 (Wednesday).

(3) Admission notice

▪ A letter of admission notice will be sent by mail to those who have submitted their intent to enroll confirmation on September 8, 2023 (Friday).

8 Withdrawal

If you wish to withdraw your enrollment, please submit the withdrawal notification (Form No. 4) to the Fujinokuni Junior High School.

9 Accommodation for applicants with disabilities

If you have a disability and want to receive reasonable accommodation during the interview, please indicate your request in item "5. Information you wish to relay to the school and things you are worried about at the school" in the interview document (Form No. 2)". Please write down the details and the reason.

10 Measures when the Japan Meteorological Agency issues an "Emergency Information on the Nankai Trough Earthquake"

(1) If the announcement is issued before the interview date

Gather information about the earthquake and safety information from television, radio or smartphones. You can also check the "Information Update" on the Shizuoka Prefectural Fujinokuni Junior High School website.

(2) If the announcement is issued on the day of the interview

- The interview will be cancelled. Please follow the instructions of the staff when evacuating to a safe place.
- Please follow the instructions posted on the "Information Update" on the Shizuoka Prefectural Fujinokuni Junior High School website regarding the resumption of the application process.
