

Shizuoka Prefectural Fujinokuni Junior High School 2026 Recruitment Guidelines

1 Purpose of studying at Shizuoka Prefectural Fujinokuni Junior High School

It is a school for people who did not finish their grades 1 through 9 education (elementary school to junior high school) due to unforeseeable circumstances or those who graduated from junior high school but barely attended school, to study junior high school level academic subjects. It is not a place for those who solely wish to study Japanese.

2 School location

3 Admission qualifications

Applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- Resident of Shizuoka Prefecture.
- Age 15 years or older by April 1, 2026 (born before April 1, 2011).
- Have not completed elementary school or junior high school in Japan or abroad or have graduated from junior high school without being able to study adequately.
- As a general rule, applicants who are foreign nationals must not have a "Student" status of residence indicated in their residence card.

※ It is possible to transfer while the applicant is in their second or third year (instead of entering as a first-year student). However, additional requirements apply in the case of a transfer. For more details, please contact Fujinokuni Junior High School.

※ Even if you apply to Fujinokuni Junior High School, you can still apply to high school as well.

4 School district

Anyone living in Shizuoka Prefecture can enroll.


5 Application procedure

(1) Application period

October 27th, 2025 (Mon) to October 31st, 2025 (Fri)

A. For in-person submissions: 10:45 am until 8:45 pm (Excluding Saturdays and Sundays)

B. By mail: Must be postmarked by Friday, October 31st, 2025




(2) How to Apply

- Please personally submit the necessary documents to the Fujinokuni Junior High School Iwata Campus or send it by simplified registered mail (*kan'i kakitome*).
- For those sending their application and documents by simplified registered mail (*kan'i kakitome*), please call the Fujinokuni Junior High School Iwata Campus prior to sending the documents. Make sure to only use simplified registered mail (*kan'i kakitome*) when mailing.
- Transportation expenses for personal submission of documents and/or postage fee for mailing shall be borne by the applicant.

(3) Documents to be submitted (required documents)

Please submit the documents listed below, from A to E, using an A4 envelope (*kakugata 2 gō*) (323mm×240mm) and affix the address label, which is downloadable from the school's official site, to the application envelope. Be sure to fill in the applicable sections with your postal code, address, and name. When sending by mail, please attach a stamp worth 530 yen and make sure to send it by simplified registered mail (*kan'i kakitome*). Place the documents in the envelope without folding them.


- Application form (Form No. 1-2)
- Interview documents (Form No. 2)
- Residence certificate (*jūminhyō*) (1 original and 1 photocopy) *

For Japanese nationals only

- Must have been issued within the last 3 months.
- The following details can be omitted on the residence certificate.
(Permanent domicile (*honseki*), information of other household members, My Number information, resident record code, name of the head of household, and your relationship to the head of household)

- Copy of residence card (front and back) * For foreign nationals only
- Self-addressed reply envelopes (2 envelopes)

Please attach your address label (write your postal code, address, and name) on the reply envelope, and a stamp worth 460 yen on each long envelope (*nagagata 3gō*) (235mm×120mm).

(5) Accommodations for applicants with disabilities

Please write down the details and reasons for requiring accommodations.

(6) Change of address

If after submitting your documents there is a change of address, please call or email the Iwata Main Campus directly to notify the school of these changes.

6 Interview

(1) Venue

Shizuoka Prefectural Fujinokuni Junior High School - Iwata Main Campus

(2) Interview procedure

The interview will be about 20 minutes long for each applicant.

We will check your admission qualifications and ask about your goals after enrollment.

(3) Interview date

You will be contacted at a later date with more information.

7 Selection of students

(1) Notification of interview results

You will be contacted at a later date with your results.

(2) Confirmation of intent to enroll

- Those who are eligible for admission based on the interview result notification should complete the enclosed intent to enroll confirmation form (Form No. 3) which will be sent out with the Notice of Results. Submit the completed Form No. 3 directly to the Iwata Main Campus or send it by mail.
- If you send it by mail, please call the Iwata Main Campus before sending. Make sure to send it by simplified registered mail (*kan'i kakitome*).
- Expenses to personally submit the documents or postage fees for mailing are to be borne by the applicant.

(3) Admission notice

An admission notice will be sent out in the mail to those who have submitted their Intent to Enroll forms.

8 Withdrawal

If you wish to withdraw your application at any point after submitting your Intent to Enroll form, please contact the school via phone or email.
